Horizon helps Blood Bikes Wales get new bike

Blood Bikes North Wales has purchased a new motorcycle for transporting blood across the region, with help from Horizon Nuclear Power.

The charity purchased a Triumph Sprint after a generous donor gave £5000 to the organisation in her will and Horizon provided the final funding needed to buy the bike.

The organisation provides a valuable service to the region – delivering blood and other essential medical items to the hospitals of North Wales, outside the hours the NHS transport system operates. The charity's service means potentially life-saving supplies can be delivered to patients on weekends and holidays without costing the NHS money.
