Date and location announced for Horizon's June Open Surgery

Local people can meet with the Horizon Nuclear Power team and ask questions about its plans for a new nuclear power station at Wylfa at the company's next Open Surgery event on Monday 17 June at Cemaes Village Hall.

As with previous monthly Open Surgeries, the event will take place between 1pm and 7pm.

The event follows the company's recent announcement that it has signed a major contract with Hitachi-GE Nuclear Energy to carry out initial design work for the new power station. It also follows a successful supply chain event at Llandudno which attracted over 200 companies to learn how they can become involved in the project at Wylfa, which will create a peak workforce of up to 6,000 during construction and around 1,000 permanent jobs over many decades to operate the plant.

Alan Smith, Head of Site Development at Horizon Nuclear Power, said: "Our monthly events are a great way for local people to meet our team, give us their feedback and ask any questions they may have.

"Following the recent signing of the contract to begin design work for the new power station at Wylfa, we can now start developing a more detailed timeline for the construction and operation of the station and develop our approach to building our supply chain, providing opportunities for local companies. - Horizon Nuclear Power was formed in 2009 to develop new nuclear power stations in the UK. The company was acquired by Hitachi Ltd of Japan in November 2012 from previous joint

owners RWE npower and E.ON UK.

- Hitachi-GE Nuclear Energy, Ltd., (Hitachi-GE) is the technology provider and 'delivery team' leader for Horizon's developments at Wylfa on the Isle of Anglesey and Oldbury-on-Severn in South Gloucestershire. Hitachi-GE is owned 80.01% by Hitachi Ltd and 19.99% by GE.
- Horizon's developments at Wylfa and Oldbury will represent multibillion pound investments in the UK's infrastructure. Each is expected to create up to 6000 jobs at peak during the construction phase, and around 1000 during operation.
- Horizon holds grid connection agreements and owns land suitable for the development of new nuclear power stations at Wylfa on the Isle of Anglesey and Oldbury-on-Severn in South Gloucestershire. Both sites are nominated for nuclear development under the National Policy Statement for Nuclear (EN-6).
