

Date and location for November Wylfa open surgery announced

Local people can meet with the Horizon Nuclear Power team and ask questions about its plans for a new nuclear power station at Wylfa at the company's next open surgery event on 21 November in Llangefni.

Ahead of formal consultation on the project in early 2012, Horizon will continue to hold its monthly open surgeries over the coming months. As with previous surgeries, they will give local people the opportunity to ask questions and meet members of the project team.

The surgery will take place between 1pm and 7pm on Monday 21 November at the Communities First Centre in Llangefni.

Alan Smith, Head of Site Development at Horizon Nuclear Power, said: "In the lead up to consultation in early 2012, we're keen to make it as easy as possible for local people to meet us and find out about our plans. The open surgeries are a good opportunity to do this, so if you have any questions, or just want to know more about the project, please do come along."

Horizon Nuclear Power Ltd. Horizon Nuclear Power is a joint venture established in 2009 by E.ON UK and RWE npower. The company is developing proposals for new nuclear power stations at Wylfa on the Isle of Anglesey and at Oldbury-on-Severn in Gloucestershire.

A new nuclear power station at Wylfa would deliver enough low carbon electricity for more than 5 million households. It is expected that around 5000 people would be employed during construction and around 800 permanent jobs during operation.
