New locations announced for Wylfa open surgeries

Members of the public and local businesses can meet the Horizon Nuclear Power team and ask questions about their proposals during a series of new open surgeries this summer.

Between July and September, Horizon Nuclear Power will continue to hold monthly drop-in sessions in venues around Anglesey and has now added new locations to enable more people to attend an open surgery near them.

Alan Smith, Head of Site Development at Horizon Nuclear Power, said: "We're very pleased to be holding our next open surgeries in Llangefni and Menai Bridge as we want to make it as convenient as possible for local people to come along and ask us their questions. Our open surgeries in Cemaes have always been very popular and I'm sure the new venues will be well attended too."
