## Horizon Nuclear Power continues sponsorship of Anglesey Agricultural Society

**Horizon Nuclear Power has confirmed its ongoing commitment to supporting the Anglesey Agricultural Society - including its popular Anglesey Show - with the announcement of a further £5,000 sponsorship for 2018.**

Horizon has been a sponsor of the Anglesey Agricultural Society since 2013 and has had a presence at the Anglesey Show for the last nine years. This newly-announced financial backing will be used to sponsor the main pavilion for all the events held at the showground this year.

At the Anglesey Show in August, the Horizon team will be based in its usual space – adjacent to the main show jumping ring – giving visitors the chance to try out a number of exciting science, technology, engineering and maths (STEM) activities, as well as the opportunity to meet the team.

**Gwen Parry-Jones, Director of Nuclear Operations at Horizon Nuclear Power**, said: “The Anglesey Agricultural Society is host to one of the biggest and best community events on the island – the Anglesey Show – and we’re proud to continue sponsoring the organisation again this year.

“Having a presence at the show is a great way for us to speak to local people in a fun and relaxed environment, while supporting such an important island-based organisation. We’re committed to building and sustaining positive relationships with local communities and look forward to welcoming everyone into our marquee again in August.”
