



Mynydd Ithel Reptile Receptor Site

Horizon has leased a 5ha area of farmland next to the proposed Wylfa Newydd development boundary for use as a receptor site for common lizards and adders translocated during site clearance works.

Work commenced in 2017 to enhance the suitability of the receptor site for reptiles. This included native scrub planting, hibernacula creation and fencing to exclude grazing animals. The site will be managed to encourage establishment of a mosaic of open grassland and scrub habitats, with suitable areas for reptiles to bask, forage, shelter and hibernate.
