Cylch Meithrin Amlwch offers a vital service to the children and parents of the Anglesey town through affordable daily playgroup sessions for pre-school children.

The nursery applied to Horizon Nuclear Power's Charitable Donations, Community Support and Sponsorship scheme – which provides funding support to local charities, projects and groups – to help them purchase new technology to support children's development.

Funded almost entirely through community fundraising and charitable donations, Cylch Meithrin Amlwch is a cornerstone of the local community and continues to thrive through the dedication of staff and volunteers. The aim of the group is to promote the education and development of children from two years old to school age with special focus on developing social skills and learning through play.

While Welsh is the primary language of the nursery, all local children are welcome to attend the daily sessions regardless of which language is spoken at home.

Llinos Wyn Williams, committee member of Cylch Meithrin Amlwch said: *"The benefit of this funding is far reaching – directly, our 28 children will benefit from technological advances in preparation for primary school. Each and every child will learn about wildlife, science, and the Welsh language through interactive visuals."*

In the long term the contributions of Horizon to Cylch Meithrin Amlwch will undoubtedly offer a fantastic foundation to the children. And who knows, there may be a future Wylfa Newydd engineer in the group!"
