Lighting up Y Ganolfan, Brynsiencyn

The future of Y Ganolfan, Brynsiencyn, is much brighter after a charitable donation from Horizon helped the organisation install energy efficient lighting and timers for its heating system – reducing its electricity usage by 80 per cent.

The village hall is a popular venue used by the whole community to host events and activities. This includes the archaeology and history society, arts and crafts groups, dance and exercise classes, bingo, youth club and coffee mornings.

The building's management team requested funding from Horizon which included the installation of new energy efficient light fittings, which has reduced the building's electricity usage by 80 per cent. New timer switches have also enabled the organisation to manage the heating system more accurately and save energy, keeping costs down and putting that money to better use within the community.

Dave Shone, Chair of Y Ganolfan, Brynsiencyn, said: *"We're over the moon with the updated lighting and heating systems, which have reduced our overall bills and kept our running costs down. The savings should help us to provide a nice, clean, warm and affordable village hall for the local community to use for years to come. Along with our new decor, we're thrilled with the transformation of Y Ganolfan and would like to thank Horizon and everyone else for their support."*
