

## Activity 5 – Follow-on activity

Carry out a review of the energy your school uses.

You might need to have a look around the school, and ask whoever takes care of the school building.

Here is a list of questions you might want to think about. Or you can make up your own!

- Are all the lights switched off when a room isn't in use?
- What is the temperature like in the classrooms?
- Public buildings A/B/C energy efficiency (for follow-on 2)
- Is the heating turned off at the weekend?
- Are the computers switched off when they aren't being used?
- Are the light bulbs energy efficient?
- Are the notebooks recycled?
- Are there electric hand dryers or paper towels in the toilets?
- Do the taps turn off automatically?
- How do most people get to and from school?
- Is any food wasted after lunch?
- Are the windows doubled glazed?
- Is there insulation in the roof?

Where do you think the most energy is used?

Do you have any energy-saving ideas to help make your school more green? For example, some schools use rainwater to flush toilets!
